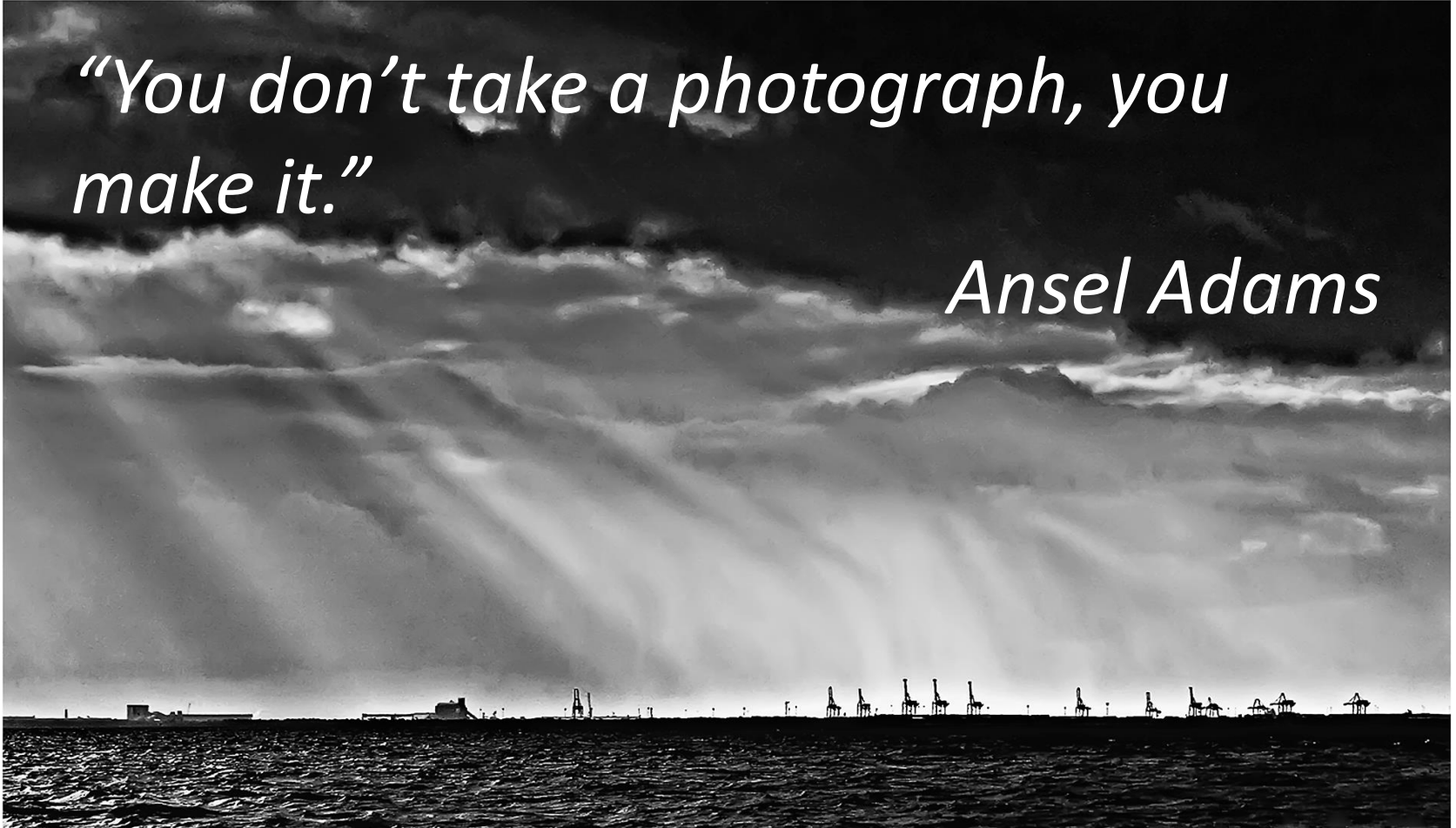



The Exhibition is conducted in accordance with the recommendations and approval of the Australian Photographic Society (APS). Approval number 2019/9.

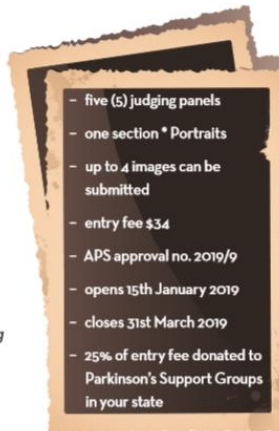
This competition is informally titled "Portraits for Parkinson's" because 25% of your entry fee will be **donated to aid Parkinson's Disease** support groups in your state.
