

Thank you for your interest and welcome to the Mount Gravatt Photographic Society, a community based, non-profit incorporated association. We look forward to your participation in the club's activities and sharing our mutual interest in photography with you.

Club Meetings: The club meets at 7:30pm on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month (except for the Xmas break), at the St Bartholomews Hall (situated behind the church), Cnr Logan Road and Mountain Street, Mt Gravatt. Please note, we DO NOT meet every fortnight as some months have 5 Wednesdays.

First Meeting of the month is a Guest Speaker, lecture or practical night.

Second Meeting of the month is competition judging night. Print and digital images are displayed and judged by a photographic Society of QLD (PSQ) accredited judge. Acceptance, Credits, Merits and Honours are awarded. Entries for the next month's competition close on this night. Prints are brought to the meeting and digital images lodged on line.

Club competitions (not compulsory): Each month we have a set subject and an open subject competition. You may enter one image in each in both the print and digital competitions. Subject details are found on the MGPS Website. The competitions are judged in four grades – B (Beginner) grade, AB (Advanced Beginner) grade, A (Advanced) grade and A Gold, a grade reserved for A graders with a long term and consistent record of photographic excellence.

Grading - After joining, the club invites new members to submit approximately 10 samples of their current work (prints or digital images on a USB stick) for club competition grading and then allocation of a club number. Once you have been allocated a club number you are eligible to enter the month competitions.
